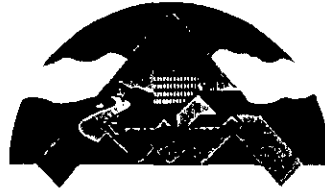

17.24.115 City of North Las Vegas Municipal Code: Portable political signs are permitted in any land use district, subject to the provisions and limitations contained in this chapter provided a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per candidate, issue or ballot question is first remitted to the City of North Las Vegas City Clerk's Office, regardless of the number of signs placed. The purpose of the fee is to provide the City with the name and pertinent information about the campaign manger or party responsible for repair of damaged or hazardous signs, and to monitor and remove all unclaimed signs following the election. Signs placed within the North Las Vegas city limits without first submitting the proper fee shall be removed and impounded until the said fee is paid in full.

Shari Buck has lived in North Las Vegas all her life. She was elected to the North Las Vegas City Council in July 1999 and is serving her first term. She represents Ward 4.

North Las Vegas is currently the second fastest growing large city in America and Councilman Buck has witnessed the transformation of this small town into a thriving community with a bright future. "As a life-long resident of North Las Vegas, my desire is to see our City become a place where good government leads the way toward a great quality of life, strengthened by managed-growth, high ethical standards, and citizens participating to shape our destiny," she said.

Councilman Buck is a member of the Regional Transportation Commission, and Regional Flood Control District, Southern Nevada Water Authority, Library District Board of Trustees, Redevelopment Agency, the Colorado River Commission, is the Chairman of the Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition, and serves on the Deferred Compensation Advisory Committee. Prior to being elected, she served on the City of North Las Vegas Planning Commission and the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board.

Councilman Buck has a Bachelor of Arts degree in English from Brigham Young University. Upon being elected to the North Las Vegas City Council, she chose to give up her career as a substitute teacher in the Clark County School District to devote all her time to serving the citizens of North Las Vegas. In her spare time, she enjoys spending time with her husband, Keith, and their four children, Jenna, Jordan, Jesse, and Kacy. Her hobbies include scuba diving and writing.

CODE OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES

There are basic principles of decency, honesty and fair play which every candidate for public office in the State of Nevada has a moral obligation to observe and uphold, in order that, after vigorously contested but fairly conducted campaigns, the voters may exercise their constitutional right to vote for the candidate of their choice and that the will of the people may be fully and clearly expressed on the issues.

THEREFORE:

- 1. I will conduct my campaign openly and publicly and limit attacks against my opponent to legitimate challenges to his voting record or qualifications for office.***
- 2. I will not use character defamation or other false attacks on a candidate's personal or family life.***
- 3. I will not use campaign material which misrepresents, distorts or otherwise falsifies the facts, nor will I use malicious or unfounded accusations which are intended to create or exploit doubts, without justifications, about the personal integrity of my opposition.***
- 4. I will not condone any dishonest or unethical practice which undermines the American system of free elections or impedes or prevents the full and free expression of the will of the voters.***

I, the undersigned, as a candidate for election to public office in the State of Nevada, hereby voluntarily pledge myself to conduct my campaign in accordance with the principles and practices set forth in this code.

- If I am a *candidate* for public office and have contributions that remain unspent from the previous election cycle, I **must** file the required Disposition of Unspent Contributions Report even though:
 - (1) I withdraw my candidacy;
 - (2) I have no opposition;
 - (3) I lose the primary;
 - (4) My name does not appear on either the primary or general election ballot;
 - (5) I am elected to office;
 - (6) I do not file a declaration of candidacy, but am a candidate as defined in NRS 294A.005 because I have received campaign contributions in excess of \$100; or
 - (7) My name is removed from the ballot by court order or a judge determines I am ineligible to run for office after I have filed my declaration of candidacy for office.
- If I am an *elected public officer* and have contributions that remain unspent from the previous election cycle, I **must** file the required Disposition of Unspent Contributions Report **every** January 15 during my term of office. I **must** also file (if contributions remain) within two months after I no longer hold office due to resignation, removal from office or expiration of term.
