## **Section A**

This filing is due no later than the 10<sup>th</sup> day after the last day to qualify as a candidate.

- **Appointment FDS** is required of a public officer appointed to fill the unexpired term of an elected or an appointed public officer and all appointed public officers that are entitled to receive compensation of \$6,000 or more annually for serving in that office.
  2. The appointment filing is required to be filed within 30 days after the appointment is made.
  3. If you are appointed 30 days or less prior to Jan. 15<sup>th</sup>, you may file one form for both the annual filing and the appointment filing. In this instance you would mark both the "annual" and the "appointment" box.

**FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENT**  
**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**1. Who is required to file a Financial Disclosure Statement?**

Every *candidate for public office* who, if elected, will be entitled to receive compensation of \$6,000 or more annually for serving in the office in question. [NRS 281A.610, Subsection 1]

Every *elected public officer*. [NRS 281A.610, Subsection 1]

Every *appointed public officer* who is entitled to receive compensation of \$6,000 or more annually for serving in the office in question. [NRS 281A.600, Subsection 1]

**2. Who is a "public officer" and what is a "public office?"**

"*Public officer*" is a person elected or appointed to a position established by the constitution of the State of Nevada, a statute of this state or an ordinance of any of its counties or incorporated cities and which involves the exercise of a public power, trust or duty.

"Public power, trust or duty" means (a) actions taken in an official capacity that involve a substantial and material exercise of administrative discretion in the formulation of public policy; (b) the expenditure of public money; *and* (c) the enforcement of laws and rules of the state, a county or a city. "Public officer" does not include (a) any justice, judge or other officer of the court system; (b) any member of a board, commission or other body whose function is advisory; (c) any member of a board of trustees for a general improvement district or special district whose official duties do not include the formulation of a budget for the district or the authorization of the expenditure of the district's money; or (d) a county health officer appointed pursuant to NRS 439.290.

"*Public office*" does not include an office held by (a) any justice, judge or other officer of the court system; (b) any member of a board, commission or other body whose function is advisory; (c) any member of a board of trustees for a general improvement district or special district whose official duties do not include the formulation of a budget for the district or the authorization of the expenditure of the district's money; or (d) a county health officer appointed pursuant to NRS 439.290.

### **3. When must the Financial Disclosure Statement be filed?**

**Candidates for public office** must file a Financial Disclosure Statement no later than the 10<sup>th</sup> day after the last day to qualify for the office. [NRS 281A.610, Subsection 1(a)]

**Elected public officers** must file an annual Financial Disclosure Statement on or before January 15<sup>th</sup> of each year of the term, including the year the term expires. [NRS 281A.610, Subsection 1(b)]

**Appointed public officers entitled to receive annual compensation of \$6,000.00 or more** must file a Financial Disclosure Statement within 30 days of their appointment and annually thereafter on or before January 15<sup>th</sup>. [NRS 281A.600, Subsection 1]

### **4. What is the civil penalty for willfully failing to timely file a Financial Disclosure Statement?**

1-10 days late: \$25.00

11-20 days late: \$50.00

21-30 days late: \$100.00

31-45 days late: \$250.00

45 or more days late (or not filed): \$2,000

### **5. If I serve in more than one public office, must I file multiple Financial Disclosure Statements?**

No. A public officer may use one Financial Disclosure Statement to satisfy the filing requirements of NRS 281A.600 and/or NRS 281A.610. Merely list all elected and appointed offices held on the form, and file copies with both the Nevada Commission on Ethics and the Secretary of State.

### **6. What is the definition of "household" for purposes of the Financial Disclosure Statement?**

"Household" includes:

(a) The spouse of a candidate for public office or public officer;

(b) A person who does not live in the same home or dwelling, but who is dependent on and receiving substantial support from the candidate for public office or public officer; and

(c) A person who lived in the home or dwelling of the candidate for public office or public officer for 6 months or more in the year immediately preceding the year in which the candidate or public officer files the financial disclosure statement.

[NRS 281A.620, Subsection 3(b)]

### **7. What does the Commission interpret "entitled to receive annual compensation"?**

The Commission has interpreted "entitled to receive annual compensation" with the adoption of NAC 281.225, as follows:

**NAC 281.225 Statements of financial disclosure: "Entitled to receive annual compensation" interpreted.**

**(NRS 281.471)** As used in NRS 281.559, the Commission will interpret "entitled to receive annual compensation" to mean entitled to receive any remuneration, not including any reimbursement for lodging, meals or travel, or any combination thereof, which a public officer has a right to receive for serving in the office in question.
