

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The City of North Las Vegas Scholarship Program offers support to North Las Vegas residents for parks and recreation programs and provides residents the opportunity to participate in more programs through a subsidy percentage.

The Scholarship Program is only available to North Las Vegas residents for parks and recreation programs including:

- Aquatics Memberships
- Classes
- Fitness Memberships
- Youth Sports Programs

SCHOLARSHIP

Individuals who wish to apply for a Parks and Recreation Program and Activities Scholarship must complete this application and return it to the City of North Las Vegas Parks and Recreation Department. Funding is first-come, first-serve, limited to available funds. Submitting this application does not guarantee a scholarship will be awarded to the participant.

CRITERIA & ELIGIBILITY

Criteria — The City of North Las Vegas Parks and Recreation Department will provide a limited number of youth scholarships for children ages 3-17. Scholarships are limited to available funds. Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis until limited funding is exhausted.

- Families may be awarded up to \$200 per household to be used exclusively for any City of North Las Vegas Parks and Recreation activities or classes.
- If awarded, the funds can only be used from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025. Applications expire on June 30, 2025.
- Any unused scholarship monies will be forfeited, and will not be available the following year, nor can it be transferred to other family members.
- The award cannot be transferred to another household or City of North Las Vegas account and cannot be refunded for cash.
- Class cancellations must fully adhere to City policy as stated on your ActiveNet registration receipt.
- If any participant misses 60% of a class in one session, they may be dropped from that session and forfeit the amount of the full scholarship.
- The scholarship award is NOT eligible toward Safekey or City of North Las Vegas Childcare programs. For more information on financial aid for these programs, please visit:

Eligibility — Any resident within the City of North Las Vegas is eligible to apply for youth in their household ages 3-17. Applicant must provide proof of North Las Vegas residency. Those who meet the guidelines and provide all necessary documents are eligible.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

APPLY

1. Submit your completed youth scholarship application (one form per household) four weeks prior to the start of the class session you are signing-up for. A minimum of four weeks is required to review scholarship applications. Applications not submitted by the four-week deadline will be considered for the next session.
2. Submit proof of North Las Vegas residency. State issued driver's license, identification card, or a recent utility bill issued within one year is eligible proof.
3. A current ActiveNet registration account. You can register for an account at the link here: [City of North Las Vegas Registration Link](#)
4. Applicants must submit a complete application, with verification of approved enrollment in a financial assistance program that lists the name of the applicant and household members as listed on the scholarship application. Verification outside the current program year will not be accepted. Applications will not be accepted unless verification of enrollment in financial assistance is uploaded.
5. Your application will be processed and reviewed for approval. Submitting an application does not guarantee that a scholarship will be awarded. Scholarship applications must be approved before enrolling into classes. Applicant will be notified within five (5) business days.
6. If the scholarship application is approved, the applicant will receive notice via email and the award will be added to the family's ActiveNet account. Award of a scholarship does not guarantee enrollment and does not replace the registration process. To setup an account and register, visit [City of North Las Vegas Registration Link](#)
7. Families must apply annually for scholarships.

Applicant must provide proof of acceptance in any of the following financial assistance programs:

- CCAP (Child Care Assistance Program)
- Medicaid
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Supplemental Social Security (SSI)
- Financial Assistance Service (FAS) Check Stub
- Social Security Disability (SSD)
- Welfare Set Aside Program (WSAP)
- Veteran's Retirement
- Women Infant Children (WIC)
- Foster Care (Guardianship Court Documentation)
