Applicants must live or work in the City of North Las Vegas, be at least 18 years old, and have no felony, gross misdemeanor, or misdemeanor convictions. All applicants must complete a background screening. Participants may only miss one class. Appropriate attire is business casual (for example: slacks and a collared shirt). No weapons, jeans, shorts, t-shirts or open-toed shoes are allowed.

Successful completion of this academy does not qualify the attendee as a Police Officer, nor does any portion of the training certify the participant in any way.
