Red Curb Painting Program

- Per Nevada Revised Statute 484B.450 and North Las Vegas Municipal Code 10.48.050, parking is prohibited within 15 feet of a fire hydrant. This distance shall be measured from the center of the fire hydrant.
- 2. Red curbs are provided as a courtesy to motorists and are not required in order to enforce the law.
- 3. Curbs are painted on a five-year rotation or as resources permit. Homeowners associations may hire a contractor to have their curbs painted if they apply for an off-site permit.
- 4. Red curb shall be painted in front of fire hydrants only. The addition of any other red curb areas requires written permission from the City Traffic Engineer.
- 5. Red curb markings shall be painted on the vertical face of the curb and the top of the curb only. No paint will be permitted on the gutter, the pavement or the sidewalk.
- 6. Red curb shall not extend into any driveway.
- 7. Red curb shall not be painted around the curb return.
- 8. If the curb painting is conducted from the street, temporary traffic control is required. Workers shall have the appropriate personal protective equipment in all instances.
- 9. Paint used for red curb applications shall be intended for use on Portland cement concrete.
- 10. Drips, spills, and other accidental paint applications shall be removed immediately.
- 11. Volunteer work shall be limited to residential streets only.
