Note: A property owner who has installed or intends to install a solar collection system shall be responsible for negotiating with other property owners in the vicinity for any necessary solar easement and shall record the easement with the County Recorder.

I have read the above and know the contents thereof to be true and correct. I further state that I am familiar with any ordinances of the city of North Las Vegas and with the statutes of the State of Nevada now in effect covering the construction of structures of the type above and agree to construct said structure in conformity therewith. I further agree any error in checking the plans submitted herewith or in examination of the above on the part of the inspector or engineer does not relieve me, the applicant of the responsibility to comply with all state and local codes, ordinances and laws governing same.

Demolition/Renovation: All permits involving partial or complete demolition, renovation, or similar types of work may require the holder of this permit to submit an Asbestos NESHAP Notification of Asbestos Abatement form and/or obtain a Dust Control Permit. You are required to contact Clark County Department of Air Quality and Environmental Management at 455-5942 prior to performing any such work. Owner Builder Affidavit of Exemption (when applicable): Per Nevada Revised Statutes 278.573, state law requires construction to be done by licensed contractors. If you are obtaining a permit under an exemption to that law, the exemption allows you, as the owner of your property, to act as your own contractor with certain restrictions although you do not have a license. You must directly supervise the construction, on the job, yourself. The building or residence must be for your own use or occupancy. It may not be built or improved for sale or lease. If you sell or lease a building you have built or improved yourself within 1 year after the construction is complete, it is presumed that you built or improved it for sale or lease, which is a violation of this exemption and a violation of chapter 624 of NRS. You may not hire an unlicensed person to act as your contractor or to supervise people working on your building. It is your responsibility to make sure that people employed by you have the licenses required by state law and by county or municipal licensing ordinances. You may not delegate the responsibility for supervising work to a contractor unless he is licensed to perform the work being done. Any person working on your building who is not licensed must work under your direct supervision and must be employed by you, which means that you must deduct FICA and withholding tax and provide industrial insurance and pay the required contribution for unemployment compensation for that employee, and comply with other state and federal laws relating to employment. Your construction must comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, building codes and zoning regulations. Homeowner is responsible to maintain proper drainage.
