City of North Las Vegas Substantial Amendment to The City of North Las Vegas Annual Action Plan (AAP) PY 2023 – 2024

INFORMATION:

The STEM Center of Excellence was approved by the City of North Las Vegas City Council along with the PY 2022 Amended Annual Action Plan on March 03, 2021. The STEM Center of Excellence is located in the City's Choice Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy Area. This project is in response to economic development and educational advancement strategies in Southern Nevada calling for diversification of industries requiring a highly skilled STEM workforce. The \$100,000 of additional funding is necessary for the continued operation, maintenance, replacement, and installation of new/updated equipment. These funds are reallocated from uncommitted funds from PY 2018 \$76,525.03 and PY 2019 \$23,474.97.

The Urban Center for Advanced Agricultural Technologies (UCAAT) program is in direct alignment according to the implementation strategies as noted in the City of North Las Vegas 5-year Consolidated Plan, Annual Action Plan (AAP) and Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER). For PY 2023 the \$229,446.91 of much-needed funding will enable the Choice Community Garden Park to expand and grow nutritious foods, provide educational courses, develop a Farmers Market, and generate jobs. These funds are being reallocated from the following NRSA Community/Public Art program since it has had continued inactivity since inception and therefore funding from PY 2020-2022 of \$99.169.42 will be reallocated to the UCAAT. Funding from PY 2021-2022 of \$130,277.49 of the NRSA Micro Enterprise will also be reallocated to the UCAAT.

The Dolores Huerta Resource Center is slated for completion in 2023 and will house programming and services for constituents. The Resource center will offer resources such as education, financial wellbeing, health and wellness, legal services, job training, technology, art, culture and recreation. For the PY 2023 the \$146,848.18 is being reallocated from the following PY 2019 \$3,828.18 uncommitted funds; PY 2023 NRSA Arts \$35,755 and NRSA Micro Enterprise funds of \$170,265.

These projects address the need of non-profit organizations to carry out specific CDBG eligible neighborhood revitalization or economic development activities. Such activities may include job creation or retention efforts focused on the selected neighborhood. Create activities that benefit low- and moderate-income persons, up to 80% of Area Median Income. Provide eligible activities that offer a wide range of tools for neighborhood and community revitalization.
