CRAIG RANCH REGIONAL PARK GROUP SHELTERS

Shelters are ideal for family reunions, company picnics, HOA meetings, wedding receptions and other events. Reservations are taken on a first-come, first-served basis and must be made a minimum of 14 days in advance. Alcohol may be served with prior written permission from the Park Supervisor. If the event has more than 401 attendees, as well as more than 3 amenities, it will be considered a special event.

LARGE SHELTERS:

#1 *Village Lodge ~ #2 Adventure Lodge ~ #6 Garden Lodge ~ #9 Lagoon Lodge

These shelters can accommodate up to 400 people and each is equipped with 25 tables and a commercial BBQ. Reservable for a minimum of five (5) hours.

*Note: No amenities are allowed at the Village Lodge.

Reservation Fees: \$100/hr (Fri-Sun) \$33/hr (Mon-Thurs) \$120/hr (Holiday) Add-on Grass Area: \$50/hr (Fri-Sun) \$17/hr (Mon-Thurs) \$70/hr (Holiday)

Non-profit organizations receive a 25% discount with proof of a 501(c)3 approval letter.

JUMPER POLICY

The City of North Las Vegas prohibits jumpers on the grass May 1st through October 1st. Stakes or Water jumpers are not permitted. Sandbags are allowed in order to secure jumpers. These regulations are in place to ensure the safety of park visitors and to preserve the condition of the grass in the parks. Jumpers must be utilized from the City of North Las Vegas approved jumper list.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

Any changes to your reservation must be made to this office no less than 14 days from the date of the reservation. Reservations that are cancelled more than 14 days prior to the reservation will receive a 50% refund. No refunds will be issues if cancellation is less than 14 days in advance.

ALCOHOL POLICY

Alcohol may be served in Craig Ranch Regional Park ONLY. With written permission from the Park Supervisor. All groups serving alcohol will be given the following hourly fee for security:

> o-100 people: \$40/hr 101 - 250: \$80/hr 251 - 400: \$120/hr

GARDEN PLOTS

The annual fee is \$150 per plot, which also includes water usage.

MEDIUM SHELTERS: #7 The Cottage ~ #8 The Cabin

These shelters can accommodate up to 200 people and each is equipped with 7 tables and a commercial BBQ. Reservable for a minimum of five (5) hours.

Reservation Fees: \$75/hr (Fri-Sun) \$25/hr (Mon-Thurs) \$95/hr (Holiday) Add-on Grass Area: \$50/hr (Fri-Sun) \$17/hr (Mon-Thurs) \$70/hr (Holiday)

SMALL SHELTERS: #3 Teepee ~ #4 Wigwam ~ #5 Wickiup

These shelters can accommodate up to 65 people and each is equipped with at least 4 tables and a commercial BBQ. Reservable for a minimum of three (3) hours.

Note: No amenities are permitted at small shelters.

Reservation Fees: \$50/hr (Fri-Sun) \$17/hr (Mon-Thurs) \$70/hr (Holiday)

CRRP - \$50 refundable event damage deposit fee

NEIGHBORHOOD AND COMMUNITY PARKS: GROUP SHELTERS

Park permits are required for any event greater than 30 attendees, events that are advertised, or events with amenities. Reservations are taken on a first-come, first-served basis and must be made a minimum of 14 days in advance. All picnic shelters can be rented for \$75/hr, with a (2) hour minimum. Holiday rate will be \$95/hr with an additional \$150 refundable damage deposit fee. Alcohol is not permitted in CNLV parks.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Any reservations scheduled on a day with temperatures under 45 degrees, above 110 degrees, wind over 30 mph, or continuous rain. Must be rescheduled within 30 days.
